

ATTENTION: Grave Decoration Regulations

The following is a reprint of rules governing plants, flowers, and care of lots in Teton County Cemeteries.

1. Permanent floral displays of artificial flowers shall be allowed only in a concrete base as wide as the base of the monument with a recessed hole and placed either to the left, right or both, of the monument and in direct line. The outside diameter of planting inset must have a minimum of 6 inches on concrete extending beyond the planting recess.

2. Natural plants will be cared for only to the extent of being watered with the grass. Any plants that begin to deteriorate will be removed at the discretion of the Sexton. Any cut flowers will be removed.

3. All flowers, either cut, plants, or artificial, placed on the grave must be removed within 72 hours after the Memorial Day Services. Decorations may be placed one week before Memorial Day.

4. All plants or flowers, whether artificial or real, will not be allowed with the exception of the Memorial Day or funeral period, except in a recessed concrete pot with a round hole and placed either to the left, right or both of the grave stone. (New marker bases are available with these recesses provided, or in the instance of existing markers, special recessed bases will be available.)

5. The Cemetery Board is most appreciative of the cooperation of the public, and welcomes any suggestions at any time for improvements in the rules and regulations. Meetings are held at the Courthouse on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p.m.
